

Obedience: The Milgram Study

Working in groups of two or three, you need to make your own handout, explaining the research by **Stanley Milgram (1963)**.

Remember, a description of a research study **must** contain:

- Aims – what did the researcher want to find out and why?
- Procedures – what did the researcher do to carry out the study?
- Findings – what did the researcher find out (give figures if available)?
- Conclusions – what do the results mean?

You **should** also include

- Criticisms – is there anything wrong with the study (for example, does it raise any **ethical issues**, are there problems with its validity?)?

Guidelines:

- Work in groups of three
- Keep it simple
- Think & plan before putting pen to paper
- Maximum 2 sides of A4

You can use these images to help you explain the study, if you wish.
